

Terms and conditions of the StethoMe.com newsletter

valid from 25th of may 2018

§1

StethoMe sp. z o.o. [limited liability company] having its seat in Poznań in Poland at the address ul. Winogrody18A, entered into the Entrepreneur Register kept by the District Court Poznań - Nowe Miasto i Wilda in Poznań, 8th Commercial Division of the Polish National Court Register [KRS] under the KRS number 0000558650, tax identification number [NIP] 7831726542, provides a free newsletter service described in these terms and conditions and is the administrator of personal data in the form of e-mail addresses [including first and last names] of recipients of this service.

§2

Prior to granting consent to taking advantage of the newsletter service, please familiarise yourself with the content of these terms and conditions.

§3

In order to take advantage of the newsletter service, it is required to have a computer [or mobile device] with Internet access, any web browser and a configured electronic mail box [e-mail].

§4

The newsletter is a free service consisting in informing the users periodically about goods and services provided by StethoMe sp. z o.o. by sending e-mail messages to the e-mail address indicated by the user.

§5

In order to subscribe to the newsletter it is necessary to specify the e-mail address of the user in the form provided at the <http://stethome.com> website and confirm subscription to this service.

§6

The user grants consent for their personal data included in the e-mail address to be processed by StethoMe sp. z o.o. for the purposes of the user taking advantage of the newsletter service. The user has the right to access their data and to correct, rectify or remove it at any time, as well as to impose limitations on processing and to file an objection against processing. The user is also entitled, at any time, to withdraw their consent to processing of their personal data and to file a complaint to the appropriate supervisory body.

§7

StethoMe sp. z o.o. shall not provide the e-mail address or any personal data it was entrusted with to any third parties or entities.

§8

The user may unsubscribe from the newsletter service at any time. The subscription can be cancelled by clicking the "Unsubscribe" link included on the bottom of every of the e-mail messages sent by StethoMe sp. z o.o.

§9

Removal of the user's e-mail address from the newsletter database takes places immediately and is confirmed by means of a message that confirms such operation.

§10

The user grants consent to StethoMe sp. z o.o. sending advertisements and commercial information – within the meaning of the act of 18th of July 2002 on providing services by electronic means – by means of the newsletter to the e-mail address of the user.
